This Act may be cited as the Robin Hood Relief Act. 6 SECTION 2. Section 41.093, Education Code, is amended by 7 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (b-2) to read as 8 9 follows: Subject to Subsections [Subsection] (b-1) and (b-2), 10 (a) 11 the cost of each credit is an amount equal to the greater of: 12 (1) the amount of the district's maintenance and operations tax revenue per student in weighted average daily 13 14 attendance for the school year for which the contract is executed; 15 or (2) the amount of the statewide district average of 16 maintenance and operations tax revenue per student in weighted 17 average daily attendance for the school year preceding the school 18 year for which the contract is executed. 19 (b-2) If the amount of maintenance and operations tax 20 21 revenue expended by a school district per student in weighted average daily attendance exceeds the amount expended during the 22 23 preceding school year, the cost of an attendance credit for the district is reduced by the percentage by which the current 24

1 expenditure per student exceeds the expenditure per student during 2 the preceding school year.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
