- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (h), Section 711.008, Health and
- 6 Safety Code, as added by Chapter 367 (S.B. 131), Acts of the 82nd
- 7 Legislature, Regular Session, 2011, is redesignated as Subsection
- 8 (i), Section 711.008, Health and Safety Code, and amended to read as
- 9 follows:
- 10 (i) [(h)] A [Not later than September 1, 2014, a] person may
- 11 file a written application with the governing body of a
- 12 municipality to establish or use a cemetery located inside the
- 13 boundaries of the municipality. The municipality by ordinance
- 14 shall prescribe the information to be included in the
- 15 application. The governing body by ordinance may authorize the
- 16 establishment or use of a cemetery located inside the boundaries of
- 17 the municipality if the municipality determines and states in the
- 18 ordinance that the establishment or use of the cemetery does not
- 19 adversely affect public health, safety, and welfare. This
- 20 subsection applies only to a municipality that:
- 21 (1) is located in three or more counties;
- 22 (2) has a population of 18,000 or more; and
- 23 (3) does not have a cemetery within its boundaries,
- 24 other than a family cemetery.

- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
