 1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-19 SECTION 1. Section 614.127, Government Code, is amended to
 1-20 read as follows:
 1-21 Sec. 614.127. LOST OR STOLEN CARDS. If an identification
 1-22 card issued under this subchapter is lost or stolen, the law
 1-23 enforcement agency or other governmental entity that issued
 1-24 ~~[issuing]~~ the card to the peace officer, reserve law enforcement
 1-25 officer, or honorably retired peace officer shall issue a duplicate
 1-26 identification card to the officer if the ~~[may:~~
 1-27 ~~(1) require a peace officer, reserve law enforcement~~
 1-28 ~~officer, or honorably retired peace] officer submits [to submit] an~~
 1-29 ~~affidavit executed by the [peace officer, reserve law enforcement~~
