9	commission for that purpose, the commission shall establish a grant
10	program for the purpose of supporting community mental health
11	programs providing services and treatment to veterans with mental
12	<u>illness.</u>
13	(b) The commission shall contract with a private entity to
14	support and administer the grant program. The contract between the
15	commission and the private entity must require that:
16	(1) the commission and the private entity each provide
17	one-half of the money that will be awarded under the grant program;
18	(2) the private entity develop eligibility criteria
19	for grant applicants, acceptable uses of grant money by grant
20	recipients, and reporting requirements for grant recipients; and
21	(3) the private entity obtain the commission's
22	approval of the eligibility criteria, acceptable uses, and

awarding any grants under the program.
