- (a) Except as provided by <u>Subsections</u> [<u>Subsection</u>] (b) <u>and</u> 8
- 9 (c), information collected by the court, court personnel, or
- 10 prosecuting attorney during the grand jury selection process about
- a person who serves as a grand juror, including the person's home 11
- 12 address, home telephone number, social security number, driver's
- 13 license number, and other personal information, is confidential and
- may not be disclosed by the court, court personnel, or prosecuting 14

- 16 (c) The court shall collect statistical information
- regarding each grand juror's race, gender, and age. 17
