- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 19.42, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) Except as provided by <u>Subsections</u> [<del>Subsection</del>] (b) <u>and</u>
- 9 (c), information collected by the court, court personnel, or
- 10 prosecuting attorney during the grand jury selection process about
- 11 a person who serves as a grand juror, including the person's home
- 12 address, home telephone number, social security number, driver's
- 13 license number, and other personal information, is confidential and
- 14 may not be disclosed by the court, court personnel, or prosecuting
- 15 attorney.
- 16 (c) The court shall collect statistical information
- 17 regarding each grand juror's race, gender, and age. The
- 18 <u>information collected under this subsection must be made available</u>
- 19 to the public in aggregate form by the court. Any identifying
- 20 information about a grand juror collected under this subsection
- 21 must be redacted before the disclosure of the statistical
- 22 <u>information</u>.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
