A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the assessment of fourth and seventh grade public school students in writing and English language arts. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 39.023(a), Education Code, as effective 5 until on or before September 1, 2015, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) The agency shall adopt or develop appropriate criterion-referenced assessment instruments designed to assess 8 9 essential knowledge and skills in reading, English language arts [writing], mathematics, social studies, and science. Except as 10 provided by Subsection (a-2), all students, other than students 11 12 assessed under Subsection (b) or (1) or exempted under Section 39.027, shall be assessed in: 13 14 (1) mathematics, annually in grades three through seven without the aid of technology and in grade eight with the aid 15 16 of technology on any assessment instrument that includes algebra; reading, annually in grades three through eight; 17 (2) 18 English language arts [writing], (3) including spelling and grammar, in grades four and seven; 19 social studies, in grade eight; 20 (4) 21 (5) science, in grades five and eight; and 22 any other subject and grade required by federal (6) 23 law. SECTION 2. Section 39.023(a), Education Code, as effective 24

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1 on or before September 1, 2015, is amended to read as follows:

2 (a) The agency shall adopt or develop appropriate 3 criterion-referenced assessment instruments designed to assess essential knowledge and skills in reading, English language arts 4 5 [writing], mathematics, social studies, and science. Except as provided by Subsection (a-2), all students, other than students 6 7 assessed under Subsection (b) or (1) or exempted under Section 39.027, shall be assessed in: 8

9 (1) mathematics, in grades three and five without the 10 aid of technology and in grade eight with the aid of technology on 11 any assessment instrument that includes algebra;

12 (2) reading, in grades three, five, and eight;
13 (3) English language arts [writing], including
14 spelling and grammar, in grades four and seven;

social studies, in grade eight; and

(5) science, in grades five and eight.

17 SECTION 3. Section 39.023(a), Education Code, as effective 18 September 1, 2017, is amended to read as follows:

19 (a) The agency shall adopt or develop appropriate criterion-referenced assessment instruments designed to assess 20 essential knowledge and skills in reading, English language arts 21 [writing], mathematics, social studies, and science. Except as 22 provided by Subsection (a-2), all students, other than students 23 assessed under Subsection (b) or (1) or exempted under Section 24 25 39.027, shall be assessed in:

(1) mathematics, annually in grades three throughseven without the aid of technology and in grade eight with the aid

No. 1468 1 of technology on any assessment instrument that includes algebra; 2 (2) reading, annually in grades three through eight; 3 (3) English language arts [writing], including spelling and grammar, in grades four and seven; 4 5 (4) social studies, in grade eight; 6 (5) science, in grades five and eight; and 7 any other subject and grade required by federal (6) 8 law. Section 39.023, Education Code, is amended by 9 SECTION 4. adding Subsection (q) to read as follows: 10 (q) A writing sample submitted by a student in connection 11 with an assessment instrument administered under this section, 12 other than an English I or English II end-of-course assessment 13 instrument described by Subsection (c), may not be used to assess 14 15 the student's writing for purposes of accountability under this chapter or for purposes of grade promotion criteria. Except as 16 17 provided by Subsection (c), the assessment of a student's writing is governed by Section 39.0264. 18 SECTION 5. Subchapter B, Chapter 39, Education Code, 19 is amended by adding Section 39.0264 to read as follows: 20 21 Sec. 39.0264. LOCAL ASSESSMENT REQUIRED FOR WRITING IN CERTAIN GRADES. (a) To evaluate student achievement in writing, 22 each school district shall assess students in grades four and seven 23 24 in accordance with the essential knowledge and skills for writing. A district may use any method the district determines appropriate 25 26 for assessing students under this section, including portfolio 27 assessment.

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1 (b) School districts shall report to the agency, as 2 determined by agency rule, the results of assessments required 3 under this section.

4 (c) The results of assessments required under this section
5 may not be used for purposes of accountability under this chapter or
6 for purposes of grade promotion criteria.

7 SECTION 6. Not later than September 1, 2016, the Texas 8 Education Agency shall adopt or develop appropriate criterion-referenced assessment instruments designed to assess 9 essential knowledge and skills in English language arts as required 10 by Section 39.023, Education Code, as amended by this Act. 11

SECTION 7. This Act applies beginning with the 2016-2017 school year.

14 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
