- 2 relating to a limitation on the amount of school property tax
- 3 revenue that is subject to recapture under the public school

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. This Act may be cited as the Robin Hood Relief
- 7 Act.
- 8 SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 41, Education Code, is
- 9 amended by adding Section 41.0932 to read as follows:
- 10 Sec. 41.0932. LIMITATION ON TOTAL COST. Notwithstanding
- 11 any other provision of this chapter, a school district that
- 12 <u>executes an agreement to purchase all attendance credits necessary</u>
- 13 to reduce the district's wealth per student to the equalized wealth
- 14 level may not be required to pay a total amount for attendance
- 15 credits that exceeds the amount equal to 39.6 percent of the amount
- of maintenance and operations tax revenue collected by the district
- 17 for the tax year that ends during the school year for which the
- 18 <u>agreement is executed.</u>
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
