4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 423, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Section 423.0045 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 423.0045. OFFENSE: OPERATION OF UNMANNED AIRCRAFT OVER
8	TARGETED FACILITY. (a) In this section, "targeted facility"
9	means:
10	(1) a petroleum or alumina refinery;
11	(2) an electric generation facility, natural gas
12	generation facility, or nuclear electric power generation
13	<pre>facility;</pre>
14	(3) an oil or gas pipeline; or
15	(4) a chemical or rubber manufacturing facility.
16	(b) A person commits an offense if:
17	(1) the person intentionally or knowingly operates an
18	unmanned aircraft over a targeted facility; and
19	(2) the unmanned aircraft is not higher than 400 feet
20	above ground level.
21	(c) It is lawful under this section to operate an unmanned
22	aircraft over a targeted facility if the unmanned aircraft is
23	operated by:
24	(1) the federal government, the state, or a

- 1 governmental entity;
- 2 (2) a person under contract with or otherwise acting
- 3 under the direction or on behalf of the federal government, the
- 4 state, or a governmental entity;
- 5 (3) a law enforcement agency;
- 6 (4) a person under contract with or otherwise acting
- 7 under the direction or on behalf of a law enforcement agency;
- 8 (5) an owner or operator of the targeted facility;
- 9 (6) a person under contract with or otherwise acting
- 10 under the direction or on behalf of an owner or operator of the
- 11 targeted facility; or
- 12 (7) a person who has the prior written consent of the
- 13 owner or operator of the targeted facility.
- 14 (d) An offense under this section is a Class B misdemeanor,
- 15 except that the offense is a Class A misdemeanor if the actor has
- 16 previously been convicted under this section.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
