2	relating to a prohibition on a vendor contact with a member of the

5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 44, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 44.0353 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 44.0353. VENDOR CONTACT PROHIBITED. (a) This section
9	applies only to an independent school district:
10	(1) any part of which is located in a county with a
11	population of more than 1.5 million in which more than 75 percent of
12	the population lives in a single municipality; and
13	(2) that has been a party to one or more causes of
14	action involving a dispute over a vendor contract within the years
15	2000-2014.
16	(b) A member of the board of trustees of an independent
17	school district to which this section applies may not, outside a
18	public meeting of the board, have direct or indirect communication
19	with an actual or prospective bidder or offeror relating to a
20	request for proposals or an advertisement for bids during the
21	<pre>period:</pre>
22	(1) after the district has issued the request for
23	proposals or has advertised for bids on a contract; and
24	(2) before the board has awarded the contract that was

- 1 the subject of the request for proposals or the advertisement for
- 2 bids.
- 3 (c) If a trustee violates Subsection (b) by engaging in
- 4 direct or indirect communication with a bidder or offeror, the
- 5 board shall reject the bid or offer of the bidder or offeror.
- 6 (d) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), a trustee may have
- 7 direct or indirect communication with an actual or prospective
- 8 bidder or offeror if:
- 9 (1) the trustee has a substantial interest, as
- 10 determined under Section 171.002, Local Government Code, in a
- 11 business entity or in real property and complies with the
- 12 requirements of Chapter 171, Local Government Code, if applicable,
- 13 and:
- 14 (A) the business entity is an actual or
- 15 prospective bidder or offeror responding to the school district's
- 16 request for proposals or advertisement for bids and the
- 17 communication relates to the business entity's response; or
- 18 (B) the real property is offered in response to
- 19 the school district's request for proposals or advertisement for
- 20 bids and the communication relates to the real property; or
- 21 (2) the communication occurs at a trade show or
- 22 convention at which the bidder or offeror was a registered
- 23 participant and the trustee discloses at a public meeting of the
- 24 board that the communication occurred, before the earlier of:
- 25 (A) one week after the date the communication
- 26 oc<u>curred; or</u>
- (B) the date on which the board votes on the

- 1 request for proposals or advertisement for bids for which the
- 2 bidder or offeror submitted a proposal or bid.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 44.0353, Education Code, as added by
- 4 this Act, applies only to a contract for which the request for
- 5 proposals or bids was issued on or after the effective date of this
- 6 Act.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
