- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 26, Water Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 26.0134 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 26.0134. STUDY ON EFFECTS OF PLASTIC MICROBEADS IN
- 8 WATER. (a) In this section, "plastic microbead" means a
- 9 nonbiodegradable solid plastic particle measuring five millimeters
- 10 or less in size that is intentionally added to a cosmetic or
- 11 personal care product.

- 12 (b) The commission shall conduct a study to determine:
- 13 (1) the extent of the presence of plastic microbeads
- 14 in water in the state; and
- 15 (2) whether the presence of plastic microbeads in
- 16 water in the state causes pollution of that water.
- 17 <u>(c) Not later than December 1, 2016, the commission shall</u>
- 18 provide to the governor, the lieutenant governor, and the
- 19 legislature a report containing:
- 20 (1) the results of the study conducted under this
- 21 section; and
- 22 (2) if the commission determines that the presence of
- 23 plastic microbeads in water in the state causes pollution of that
- 24 water, recommendations for reducing or eliminating the pollution,

- 1 including consideration of the regulation or ban of plastic
- 2 microbeads in cosmetics and other personal care products.
- 3 (d) This section expires September 1, 2017.
- 4 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
