- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Article 103.001, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 Art. 103.001. COSTS PAYABLE. A cost is not payable by the
- 8 person charged with the cost until a written bill containing the
- 9 items of cost is:
- 10 <u>(1)</u> produced;
- 11 (2) [or is ready to be produced, containing the items
- 12 of cost, signed by the officer who charged the cost or the officer
- 13 who is entitled to receive payment for the cost; and
- 14 (3) provided to the person charged with the cost.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to a cost incurred on or after the effective date of this Act. A
- 17 cost incurred before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 18 the law in effect on the date the cost was incurred, and the former
- 19 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
