## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the assignment to a trial court of a judge or justice
- 3 who was defeated in a primary or general election.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 74.053(d), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (d) An assigned judge or justice who was defeated in the
- 8 last primary or general election for which the judge or justice was
- 9 a candidate for the judicial office held by the judge or justice may
- 10 not sit in a criminal or civil case if either party objects to the
- 11 judge or justice.
- 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 13 to the assignment of a judge or justice made on or after the
- 14 effective date of this Act. An assignment made before the effective
- 15 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before
- 16 that date, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 17 purpose.
- 18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
