## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the making and receiving of referrals for legal
- 3 services by certain legislators and executive officers; providing a

- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 572, Government Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 572.063 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 572.063. CERTAIN REFERRALS FOR LEGAL SERVICES
- 9 PROHIBITED. (a) A member of the legislature or an executive
- 10 officer elected in a statewide election who is a member of the State
- 11 Bar of Texas or who is licensed to practice law in another state or a
- 12 United States territory may not make or receive any referral for
- 13 <u>legal services for monetary compensation or any other benefit.</u>
- 14 (b) An offense under this section is a Class B misdemeanor.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to conduct that occurred on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 17 Conduct that occurred before the effective date of this Act is
- 18 governed by the law in effect on the date the conduct occurred, and
- 19 the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 20 purposes of this section, conduct occurred before the effective
- 21 date of this Act if any part of the conduct occurred before that
- 22 date.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
