## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to creation of a search and rescue task force in each

- 3 disaster field response region.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 418.043, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 418.043. OTHER POWERS AND DUTIES. The division shall:
- 8 (1) determine requirements of the state and its
- 9 political subdivisions for food, clothing, and other necessities in
- 10 event of a disaster;
- 11 (2) procure and position supplies, medicines,
- 12 materials, and equipment;
- 13 (3) adopt standards and requirements for local and
- 14 interjurisdictional emergency management plans;
- 15 (4) periodically review local and interjurisdictional
- 16 emergency management plans;
- 17 (5) coordinate deployment of mobile support units;
- 18 (6) establish and operate training programs and
- 19 programs of public information or assist political subdivisions and
- 20 emergency management agencies to establish and operate the
- 21 programs;
- 22 (7) make surveys of public and private industries,
- 23 resources, and facilities in the state that are necessary to carry
- 24 out the purposes of this chapter;

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- 1 (8) plan and make arrangements for the availability
- 2 and use of any private facilities, services, and property and
- 3 provide for payment for use under terms and conditions agreed on if
- 4 the facilities are used and payment is necessary;
- 5 (9) establish a register of persons with types of
- 6 training and skills important in disaster mitigation,
- 7 preparedness, response, and recovery;
- 8 (10) establish a register of mobile and construction
- 9 equipment and temporary housing available for use in a disaster;
- 10 (11) assist political subdivisions in developing
- 11 plans for the humane evacuation, transport, and temporary
- 12 sheltering of service animals and household pets in a disaster;
- 13 (12) prepare, for issuance by the governor, executive
- 14 orders and regulations necessary or appropriate in coping with
- 15 disasters;
- 16 (13) cooperate with the federal government and any
- 17 public or private agency or entity in achieving any purpose of this
- 18 chapter and in implementing programs for disaster mitigation,
- 19 preparation, response, and recovery;
- 20 (14) develop a plan to raise public awareness and
- 21 expand the capability of the information and referral network under
- 22 Section 531.0312;
- 23 (15) improve the integration of volunteer groups,
- 24 including faith-based organizations, into emergency management
- 25 plans;
- 26 (16) cooperate with the Federal Emergency Management
- 27 Agency to create uniform guidelines for acceptable home repairs

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- 1 following disasters and promote public awareness of the guidelines;
- 2 (17) cooperate with state agencies to:
- 3 (A) encourage the public to participate in
- 4 volunteer emergency response teams and organizations that respond
- 5 to disasters; and
- 6 (B) provide information on those programs in
- 7 state disaster preparedness and educational materials and on
- 8 Internet websites;
- 9 (18) establish a liability awareness program for
- 10 volunteers, including medical professionals;
- 11 (19) define "individuals with special needs" in the
- 12 context of a disaster;
- 13 (20) establish and operate, subject to the
- 14 availability of funds, a search and rescue task force in each field
- 15 response region established by the division to assist in search,
- 16 rescue, and recovery efforts before, during, and after a natural or
- 17 man-made disaster; and
- 18 (21)  $[\frac{(20)}{}]$  do other things necessary, incidental, or
- 19 appropriate for the implementation of this chapter.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
