- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 215, Local Government
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 215.006 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 215.006. CHURCH PROVIDING OVERNIGHT SHELTER. (a) In
- 8 this section:
- 9 (1) "Church" means a facility that is owned by a
- 10 religious organization and that is used primarily for religious
- 11 services.
- 12 (2) "Religious organization" means an organization
- 13 that meets the standards for qualification as a religious
- 14 organization under Section 11.20, Tax Code.
- 15 (b) A municipality may not adopt an ordinance, or enforce
- 16 an existing ordinance, that prohibits a church from providing
- 17 overnight shelter for children 17 years of age and younger.
- 18 (c) A municipal ordinance or regulation that relates to the
- 19 safe and sanitary operation of a homeless shelter for children
- 20 applies to a church that provides overnight shelter for children.
- 21 (d) A municipality may adopt or enforce an ordinance
- 22 establishing limits on the number of nights a child may use an
- 23 overnight shelter provided by a church or on the number of children
- 24 that can be housed in the shelter per night.
