6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Subchapter N, Chapter 1702, Occupations Code, is
8	amended by adding Section 1702.3245 to read as follows:
9	Sec. 1702.3245. CERTAIN VOLUNTEERS. (a) This chapter does
10	not apply to a person who provides volunteer security services on
11	the premises of:
12	(1) a private primary or secondary school;
13	(2) a church, synagogue, or other established place of
14	<u>religious worship; or</u>
15	(3) the regular meeting place of a nonprofit
16	organization for the duration of a meeting of the nonprofit
17	organization.
18	(b) In this section, "nonprofit organization" means an
19	organization that is exempt from federal income taxation under
20	Section 501(a), Internal Revenue Code of 1986, by being described
21	as an exempt organization by Section 501(c)(3) of that code.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
