## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 130, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 130.0095 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 130.0095. BLOCK SCHEDULING FOR ASSOCIATE DEGREE OR
8	CERTIFICATE PROGRAM. (a) To facilitate timely degree completion
9	by students at public junior colleges, each public junior college
10	shall establish, for each associate degree or certificate program
11	offered by the college, a block schedule curriculum under which:
12	(1) courses required for a student's enrollment in the
13	program as a full-time student are offered each semester in
14	scheduled blocks, such as a morning, full-day, afternoon, evening,
15	or weekend block schedule, designed to provide scheduling
16	predictability from semester to semester to students enrolled in
17	the program; and
18	(2) students may enroll in an entire block schedule
19	curriculum offered under the program in a semester, rather than
20	enrolling in individual courses leading toward the degree or
21	<pre>certificate.</pre>
22	(b) Each public junior college shall publish in advance of
23	each semester the available block schedule curricula for each

- 2 (c) The Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board may adopt
- 3 rules as necessary for the administration of this section.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 130.0095, Education Code, as added by
- 5 this Act, applies beginning with the 2016 fall semester.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
