A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the use of hotel occupancy tax revenue in certain municipalities. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 351, Tax Code, is amended by adding Section 351.1071 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 351.1071. ALLOCATION 7 OF REVENUE: CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES. (a) This section applies only to a municipality: 8 9 (1) that has a population of not more than 5,000; and (2) at least part of which is located less than 10 one-eighth of one mile from a space center operated by an agency of 11 12 the federal government. (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter, a 13 14 municipality to which this section applies may use: (1) not more than 45 percent of the revenue derived 15 from the municipal hotel occupancy tax for economic development 16 projects to enhance public areas at or in the immediate vicinity of 17 hotels or convention center facilities, including construction and 18 maintenance projects, projects improving the visual appeal of those 19 areas, and projects updating signage; and 20 21 (2) not more than 15 percent of the revenue derived 22 from the municipal hotel occupancy tax for peace officers, 23 firefighters, emergency medical services personnel, or other local government employees working at special events attended by large 24

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
