3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 437.205(b), Government Code, is amended
5	to read as follows:
6	(b) A person appointed, enlisted, or drafted in the Texas
7	military forces or who volunteers for the Texas military forces
8	shall take and subscribe <u>to the following</u> [an] oath <u>:</u>
9	"I,, do solemnly swear that I will bear true faith
10	and allegiance to the State of Texas and to the United States of
11	America, that I will serve this state and nation honestly and
12	faithfully against all enemies, and that I will obey the orders of
13	the governor of Texas and of the officers appointed over me, in
14	accordance with the laws, rules, and articles governing the
15	military forces of the State of Texas." [prescribed by the adjutant
16	general.]
17	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
