- 10 educator preparation program and successful performance on a

- 13 <u>accredited by an accrediting agency recognized by the Texas Higher</u>
- 14 Education Coordinating Board; and
- 15 (2) has at least 15 years of service with the same
- 16 school district.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
