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H.B. No. 1613

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the use of performance on certain assessment 3 instruments designated by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating 4 Board to satisfy requirements concerning high school end-of-course 5 assessment instruments.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 39.025, Education Code, is amended by amending Subsection (a-1) and adding Subsection (a-2) to read as follows:

(a-1) A enrolled in a college preparatory 10 student mathematics or English language arts course under Section 28.014 11 12 who satisfies the Texas Success Initiative (TSI) college readiness benchmarks prescribed by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating 13 14 Board under Section 51.3062(f) on an assessment instrument designated by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board under 15 Section 51.3062(c) administered at the end of the college 16 preparatory <u>mathematics or English language arts</u> course satisfies 17 the requirements concerning and is exempt from the administration 18 of the Algebra I or the English I and English II [an] end-of-course 19 assessment <u>instruments, as applicable</u>, [in an equivalent course] as 20 prescribed by Section 39.023(c), even if the student did not 21 perform satisfactorily on a previous administration of the 22 23 applicable end-of-course assessment instrument [Subsection (a)]. A student who fails to perform satisfactorily on the assessment 24

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instrument designated by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board under Section 51.3062(c) administered as provided by this subsection may retake that assessment instrument for purposes of this subsection or may take the appropriate end-of-course assessment instrument.

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6 (a-2) The commissioner shall determine a method by which a 7 student's satisfactory performance on an advanced placement test, 8 an international baccalaureate examination, an SAT Subject Test, the SAT, the ACT, or any nationally recognized norm-referenced 9 10 assessment instrument used by institutions of higher education to award course credit based on satisfactory performance on the 11 assessment instrument shall be used to satisfy the requirements 12 concerning an end-of-course assessment instrument in an equivalent 13 14 course as prescribed by Subsection (a). The commissioner shall 15 determine a method by which a student's satisfactory performance on the PSAT or the ACT-Plan shall be used to satisfy the requirements 16 17 concerning an end-of-course assessment instrument in an equivalent course as prescribed by Subsection (a). A student who fails to 18 19 perform satisfactorily on a test or other assessment instrument authorized under this subsection, other than the PSAT or the 20 ACT-Plan, may retake that test or other assessment instrument for 21 purposes of this subsection or may take the appropriate 22 end-of-course assessment instrument. A student who fails to 23 24 perform satisfactorily on the PSAT or the ACT-Plan must take the appropriate end-of-course assessment instrument. The commissioner 25 26 shall adopt rules as necessary for the administration of this 27 subsection.

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1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
