2	relating to providing certain information to the public and to
3	purchasers of affected property regarding impact of certain
4	military airport operations.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter 397, Local Government Code, is amended
7	by adding Section 397.007 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 397.007. PUBLIC INFORMATION REGARDING IMPACT OF
9	CERTAIN MILITARY AIRPORT OPERATIONS. (a) This section applies
10	only to an area located:
11	(1) within three miles of the boundaries of a
12	federally owned and operated military installation that includes ar
13	airport and for which an Air Installation Compatible Use Zone Study
14	or Joint Land Use Study is prepared; and
15	(2) in a county:
16	(A) with a population of more than 1.5 million
17	that contains a municipality in which at least 75 percent of the
18	county's population resides; or
19	(B) with a population of 130,000 or more that is
20	adjacent to a county described by Paragraph (A).
21	(b) A county containing an area to which this section
22	applies shall work closely with the military installation adjoining

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the area as necessary to obtain or create a map that is visually

useful in determining whether the area is located inside or outside

- 1 an accident potential zone, clear zone, or noise zone as designated
- 2 in the most recent Air Installation Compatible Use Zone Study or
- 3 Joint Land Use Study applicable to the military installation.
- 4 (c) The county shall work closely with the military
- 5 installation as necessary to update a map obtained or created under
- 6 this section.
- 7 (d) The county shall ensure that the following information
- 8 or a link to the information is publically available on the county's
- 9 Internet website:
- 10 (1) each map obtained or created and updated under
- 11 this section; and
- 12 (2) the most recent Air Installation Compatible Use
- 13 Zone Study or Joint Land Use Study applicable to each military
- 14 installation adjacent to an area to which this section applies.
- SECTION 2. Section 5.008, Property Code, is amended by
- 16 adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
- 17 (b-1) This subsection applies only to an area to which
- 18 Section 397.007, Local Government Code, is applicable. The seller
- 19 of residential real property described by Subsection (a) shall
- 20 include an additional disclosure item in the written notice given
- 21 to the purchaser of the property as required by this section that
- 22 must read substantially similar to the following:
- 23 This property is located within three miles of a
- 24 military installation that includes an airport. The
- 25 <u>seller has reviewed publically available information</u>
- provided as required by Section 397.007, Local
- 27 Government Code, and identified the designation status

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of the property based on that information as follows: 1 2 Write Yes (Y) or No (N) to each: Accident potential zone 3 4 _ Clear zone 5 High-noise zone 6 SECTION 3. Section 5.008(b-1), Property Code, as added by this Act, applies only to a transfer of property that occurs on or 7 8 after the effective date of this Act. A transfer of property that occurs before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law applicable to the transfer immediately before that date, and the 10 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For the 11 purposes of this section, a transfer of property occurs before the 12 effective date of this Act if the contract binding the purchaser to 13 purchase the property is executed before that date. 14

15 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
