The report may 18 include the secretary of state's recommendations on the future use 19 of e-mail ballot submission by members of the armed forces of the 20 21 United States and suggestions for permanent statutory authority regarding e-mail ballot submission by members of the armed forces 22 23 of the United States. 24 (e) This section expires September 1, 2017 [2015].

1 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 2 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 3 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 4 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 5 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
