## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to Medicaid billing for the services of substitute
- 3 dentists.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Human Resources Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 32.076 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 32.076. SUBSTITUTE DENTISTS. To the extent allowed by
- 8 federal law, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 9 Services Commission shall adopt rules ensuring that the same
- 10 standards applying to a physician who bills the medical assistance
- 11 program for services provided by a substitute physician apply also
- 12 to a dentist who bills the medical assistance program for services
- 13 provided by a substitute dentist.
- 14 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 15 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 16 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 17 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 18 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 19 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 20 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 21 of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human
- 22 Services Commission shall adopt the rules necessary to implement
- 23 the changes in law made by this Act.
- 24 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

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- 1 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 2 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 3 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 4 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
