BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SUBCHAPTER D. LIABILITY FOR TRAINING EXERCISES

Sec. 78.151. LIABILITY FOR TRAINING EXERCISES. A person is not liable for damages resulting from the person's execution of a training exercise intended to prepare the person to respond to a 1-26 1-27 1-28 1-29 fire or emergency to which this chapter applies to the same extent 1-30 that the person would not be liable under this chapter for damages resulting from the person's actions in responding to a fire or 1-31 1-32

LIABILITY FOR TRAINING EXERCISES. 1-35 Except in a case of reckless conduct or intentional, wilful, or wanton misconduct, a person who is immune from civil liability for an act or omission that occurs in giving care, assistance, or advice with respect to the management of an incident to which this chapter 1-36 1-37 1-38 1-39 applies is immune from civil liability for an act or omission that 1-40 occurs during the execution of a training exercise intended to prepare the person to give that care, assistance, or advice.
