A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the salary paid to certain professional employees of 3 public schools.

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- SECTION 1. Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by amending Subsections (c) and (g) and adding Subsections (c-2),
- 7 (c-3), and (d) to read as follows:
- 8 (c) The salary factors per step are as follows:

- 18 Salary Factor <u>.9854</u> [.8854]
- 19 (c-2) Notwithstanding Subsection (a), for the 2015-2016
- 20 school year, a classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time
- 21 school counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school
- 22 nurse is entitled to a monthly salary that is at least equal to the
- 23 sum of:

24 (1) the monthly salary the employee would have

- 1 received for the 2015-2016 school year under the district's salary
- 2 schedule for the 2014-2015 school year, if that schedule had been in
- 3 effect for the 2015-2016 school year, including any local
- 4 supplement and any money representing a career ladder supplement
- 5 the employee would have received in the 2015-2016 school year; and
- 6 (2) \$500.
- 7 (c-3) Subsection (c-2) and this subsection expire September
- 8 1, 2016.
- 9 (d) A classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time
- 10 school counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school
- 11 nurse employed by a school district in the 2015-2016 school year is,
- 12 as long as the employee is employed by the same district, entitled
- 13 to a salary that is at least equal to the salary the employee
- 14 received for the 2015-2016 school year.
- 15 (g) The commissioner may adopt rules to govern the
- 16 application of this section, including rules that:
- 17 (1) require the payment of a minimum salary under this
- 18 section to a person employed in more than one capacity for which a
- 19 minimum salary is provided and whose combined employment in those
- 20 capacities constitutes full-time employment; and
- 21 (2) specify the credentials a person must hold to be
- 22 considered a [speech pathologist or] school nurse under this
- 23 section.
- SECTION 2. Section 42.2513(a), Education Code, is amended
- 25 to read as follows:
- 26 (a) A school district, including a school district that is
- 27 otherwise ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled

- 1 to state aid in an amount equal to the sum of:
- 2 (1) the product of \$500 multiplied by the number of
- 3 full-time district employees, other than administrators or
- 4 employees subject to the minimum salary schedule under Section
- 5 21.402; [and]
- 6 (2) the product of \$5,000 multiplied by the number of
- 7 classroom teachers, full-time librarians, full-time school
- 8 counselors certified under Subchapter B, Chapter 21, and full-time
- 9 school nurses employed by the district; and
- 10 (3) the product of \$250 multiplied by the number of
- 11 part-time district employees, other than administrators.
- 12 SECTION 3. Section 42.2516, Education Code, as effective
- 13 until September 1, 2017, is amended by adding Subsection (e-1) to
- 14 read as follows:
- 15 <u>(e-1)</u> The amount of state aid or credit to which a school
- 16 district is entitled under Section 42.2513(a)(2) is in addition to
- 17 the amount of revenue to which the district is entitled under
- 18 Subsection (b). This subsection expires September 1, 2017.
- 19 SECTION 4. Effective September 1, 2017, Section
- 20 21.402(c-1), Education Code, is repealed.
- 21 SECTION 5. This Act applies beginning with the 2015-2016
- 22 school year.
- 23 SECTION 6. Except as otherwise provided by this Act, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
