- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 25.2223(a), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (a) A county criminal court in Tarrant County has
- 8 jurisdiction over all criminal matters and causes, original and
- 9 appellate, prescribed by law for county courts, but does not have
- 10 original civil jurisdiction. The County Criminal Courts Nos. 5 and
- 11 10 of Tarrant County also have concurrent jurisdiction within the
- 12 county of all appeals [from criminal convictions] under the laws of
- 13 this state and the municipal ordinances of the municipalities
- 14 located in Tarrant County that are appealed from the justice courts
- 15 and municipal courts in the county. The County Criminal Courts Nos.
- 16 5, 7, 8, 9, and 10 of Tarrant County also have concurrent
- 17 jurisdiction with the district court in felony cases to conduct
- 18 arraignments, conduct pretrial hearings, and accept guilty pleas.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
