Contributions required by this section shall 9 be submitted by electronic funds transfer, by wire transfer, or as 10 11 an automated clearinghouse withdrawal (ACH debit) unless the 12 executive director grants an exception based on the difficulty of a participating department's use of <a href="those">those</a> [that] payment <a href="methods">methods</a> 13 14 [method]. Contributions that are not paid within the time required

by the state board accrue interest at the most recent assumed

actuarial rate of return on investments of the fund.
