4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 707, Transportation Code, is amended by
6	adding Section 707.0022 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 707.0022. ELECTION TO REPEAL ORDINANCE. (a) The
8	governing body of a local authority shall submit to the voters of
9	the local authority the question of repealing an ordinance adopted
10	under Section 707.002 if the governing body receives a petition
11	that requests the election and is signed by 10 percent of the
12	registered voters of the local authority.
13	(b) If a majority of the votes cast at the election favor the
14	repeal of the ordinance, the governing body:
15	(1) shall repeal the ordinance; and
16	(2) may not subsequently adopt an ordinance under
17	<u>Section 707.002.</u>
18	(c) An election on the question of repealing an ordinance
19	under Section 707.002 may not be held more often than every two
20	years.
21	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
