5	SECTION 1. Subchapter F, Chapter 130, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 130.094 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 130.094. INNOVATIVE WORKFORCE TRAINING CENTER. (a) In
8	this section, "training center" means the Innovative Workforce
9	Training Center established under this section.
10	(b) The Innovative Workforce Training Center is established
11	to develop and provide initial and continuing education and
12	training for workers in the Rio Grande Valley, including education
13	and training in the following specific areas:
14	(1) welding;
15	(2) civil, commercial, residential, and industrial
16	construction;
17	(3) installing electrical systems;
18	(4) installing heating, ventilation, and
19	air-conditioning systems; and
20	(5) mechatronics.
21	(c) Texas Southmost College shall administer the training
22	center. The headquarters of the training center are located at
23	Texas Southmost College in Brownsville. The training center may
24	use property and facilities owned or leased by Texas Southmost

2	(d) The training center may solicit and accept gifts and
3	grants from any public or private source for purposes of this
4	section. The legislature may appropriate money for purposes of
5	this section.
6	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
