5	SECTION 1. REPORT ON EMPLOYEE MISCLASSIFICATION. (a) The
6	comptroller of public accounts shall prepare a report on the extent
7	to which employers in this state misclassify employees as
8	independent contractors.
9	(b) The report must include:
10	(1) an analysis of the economic impact of
11	misclassification on:
12	(A) wages;
13	(B) unemployment insurance taxes; and
14	(C) federal income and social security taxes;
15	(2) information regarding the availability to a
16	misclassified employee of the following:
17	(A) health benefits;
18	(B) pension benefits;
19	(C) workers' compensation coverage; and
20	(D) unemployment compensation benefits; and
21	(3) recommendations for legislation to decrease the
22	occurrence of employee misclassification.
23	(c) On request by the comptroller, the Texas Workforce

- 2 (d) Not later than December 1, 2016, the comptroller shall
- 3 provide a copy of the report to:
- 4 (1) the governor;
- 5 (2) the lieutenant governor;
- 6 (3) the speaker of the house of representatives; and
- 7 (4) each standing committee of the senate and house of
- 8 representatives having primary jurisdiction over matters relating
- 9 to labor and employment.
- SECTION 2. EXPIRATION. This Act expires June 1, 2017.
- 11 SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September
- 12 1, 2015.
