A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a report by the comptroller on wage theft. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. REPORT ON WAGE THEFT. (a) 4 The comptroller of 5 public accounts, in cooperation with the Texas Workforce Commission, shall prepare a report on wage theft by employers in 6 this state. 7 (b) The report must include: 8 information regarding the demographic groups and 9 (1)industries most affected by wage theft; 10 an analysis of the economic impact of wage theft on 11 (2) 12 employees and its effect on competition within an industry; and 13 an analysis, prepared by the Texas Workforce (3) 14 Commission, of: remedies available to victims of wage theft 15 (A) under state and federal law; 16 17 procedural difficulties in pursuing a remedy (B) under state or federal law; and 18 (C) recommendations for legislation to address 19 20 the difficulties described by Paragraph (B). 21 (c) Not later than December 1, 2016, the comptroller shall provide a copy of the report to: 22 23 (1) the governor; 24 (2) the lieutenant governor;

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(3) the speaker of the house of representatives; and
(4) each standing committee of the senate and house of
representatives having primary jurisdiction over matters relating
to labor and employment.
SECTION 2. EXPIRATION. This Act expires June 1, 2017.
SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September

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7 1, 2015.
