- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Article 14.06(d), Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (d) Subsection (c) applies only to a person charged with
- 9 committing an offense under:
- 10 (1) Section 481.121, Health and Safety Code, if the
- 11 offense is punishable under Subsection (b)(1) or (2) of that
- 12 section;
- 13 (1-a) Section 481.1161, Health and Safety Code, if the
- 14 offense is punishable under Subsection (b)(1) or (2) of that
- 15 section;
- 16 (2) Section 28.03, Penal Code, if the offense is
- 17 punishable under Subsection (b)(2) of that section;
- 18 (3) Section 28.08, Penal Code, if the offense is
- 19 punishable under Subsection (b)(1) of that section;
- 20 (4) Section 31.03, Penal Code, if the offense is
- 21 punishable under Subsection (e)(2)(A) of that section;
- 22 (5) Section 31.04, Penal Code, if the offense is
- 23 punishable under Subsection (e)(2) of that section;
- 24 (6) Section 38.114, Penal Code, if the offense is

- 1 punishable as a Class B misdemeanor; [ex]
- 2 (7) Section 521.457, Transportation Code; or
- 3 (8) Section 681.011, Transportation Code.
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 682.002, Transportation Code, is amended
- 5 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 682.002. CIVIL OFFENSE. (a) A municipality may
- 7 declare the violation of a municipal ordinance relating to parking
- 8 or stopping a vehicle, including parking or stopping a vehicle in a
- 9 manner that would constitute an offense under Section 681.011, to
- 10 be a civil offense.
- 11 (b) A joint board to which Section 22.074(d) applies may
- 12 declare the violation of a resolution, rule, or order of the joint
- 13 board relating to parking or stopping a vehicle, including parking
- 14 or stopping a vehicle in a manner that would constitute an offense
- 15 <u>under Section 681.011</u>, to be a civil offense.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
