- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 86.014, Election Code, is amended by
- 5 adding Subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:
- 6 (c) The early voting clerk shall, on written request,
- 7 provide a list of all voters:
- 8 (1) whom the early voting clerk provided with a ballot
- 9 to be voted by mail in the most recent election; and
- 10 (2) to whom the early voting clerk is required, as of
- 11 the date of the request, to send a ballot to be voted by mail in the
- 12 next election because those voters are eligible to receive mail
- 13 ballots for more than one election under Section 86.0015.
- 14 (d) With respect to a particular election, a person may make
- 15 a request under Subsection (c):
- 16 (1) not earlier than the date the final canvass of the
- 17 general election is completed, or if there is a runoff in the
- 18 election, the date the final canvass of the runoff election is
- 19 completed; and
- 20 (2) not later than the 60th day before the next
- 21 <u>election occurring in the territory served by the early voting</u>
- 22 clerk.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
