- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 826, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 826.018 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 826.018. LOCAL RABIES CONTROL PROGRAMS. (a) This
- 8 section applies to a veterinarian who:
- 9 (1) is employed by a county or municipality; and
- 10 (2) administers or supervises the administration of
- 11 rabies vaccine as part of a local rabies control program
- 12 <u>established by a county or municipality under this chapter.</u>
- 13 (b) A veterinarian described by Subsection (a) is not
- 14 required to establish a veterinarian-client-patient relationship
- 15 before administering rabies vaccine or supervising the
- 16 administration of rabies vaccine.
- 17 (c) To the extent of any conflict between this section and
- 18 any other law or rule relating to the administration of rabies
- 19 <u>vaccine</u>, this section controls.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
