5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 826, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 826.018 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 826.018. LOCAL RABIES CONTROL PROGRAMS. (a) This
8	section applies to a veterinarian who:
9	(1) is employed by a county or municipality; and
10	(2) administers or supervises the administration of
11	rabies vaccine as part of a local rabies control program
12	established by a county or municipality under this chapter.
13	(b) A veterinarian described by Subsection (a) is not
14	required to establish a veterinarian-client-patient relationship
15	before administering rabies vaccine or supervising the
16	administration of rabies vaccine.
17	(c) To the extent of any conflict between this section and
18	any other law or rule relating to the administration of rabies
19	vaccine, this section controls.
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
21	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
22	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
23	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
24	Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
