8	CHARGE CARD. The attorney general by rule shall develop and
9	implement a policy that encourages participation in a program
10	administered by the comptroller relating to the use of a credit or
11	charge card to pay for travel expenses.
12	SECTION 2. Section 403.023, Government Code, is amended by
13	adding Subsections (b-1) and (b-2) to read as follows:
14	(b-1) Except as provided by Subsection (b-2), if the
15	comptroller adopts rules authorized under Subsection (b), the rules
16	must:
17	(1) require a state agency in the executive branch of
18	state government to use a credit or charge card to pay for all
19	purchases unless the comptroller determines that another method of
20	payment is more advantageous to the state; and

SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 12

13 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
