- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 56.021, Utilities Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 56.021. UNIVERSAL SERVICE FUND ESTABLISHED. The
- 8 commission shall adopt and enforce rules requiring local exchange
- 9 companies to establish a universal service fund to:
- 10 (1) assist telecommunications providers in providing
- 11 basic local telecommunications service at reasonable rates in high
- 12 cost rural areas under two plans:
- 13 (A) the Texas High Cost Universal Service Plan
- 14 (16 T.A.C. Section 26.403); and
- 15 (B) the Small and Rural Incumbent Local Exchange
- 16 Company Universal Service Plan (16 T.A.C. Section 26.404);
- 17 (2) reimburse the telecommunications carrier that
- 18 provides the statewide telecommunications relay access service
- 19 under Subchapter D;
- 20 (3) finance the specialized telecommunications
- 21 assistance program established under Subchapter E;
- 22 (4) reimburse the department and the commission for
- 23 costs incurred in implementing this chapter and Chapter 57;
- 24 (5) reimburse a telecommunications carrier providing

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- 1 lifeline service as provided by 47 C.F.R. Part 54, Subpart E, as
- 2 amended;
- 3 (6) finance the implementation and administration of
- 4 an integrated eligibility process created under Section 17.007 for
- 5 customer service discounts relating to telecommunications
- 6 services, including outreach expenses the commission determines
- 7 are reasonable and necessary;
- 8 (7) reimburse a designated provider under Subchapter
- 9 F;
- 10 (8) reimburse a successor utility under Subchapter G;
- 11 [and]
- 12 (9) finance the program established under Subchapter
- 13 H; and
- 14 (10) reimburse a telecommunications carrier that
- 15 provides Internet service under Subchapter I.
- 16 SECTION 2. Chapter 56, Utilities Code, is amended by adding
- 17 Subchapter I to read as follows:
- 18 SUBCHAPTER I. INTERNET SERVICE PROGRAM FOR PERSONS WITH IMPAIRMENT
- 19 OF HEARING
- Sec. 56.351. INTERNET SERVICE PROGRAM. The commission by
- 21 rule shall establish and implement a program to provide from the
- 22 <u>universal service fund reimbursement for free or discounted</u>
- 23 Internet service provided by a telecommunications carrier to a
- 24 person with an impairment of hearing who is eligible for lifeline
- 25 service as provided by 47 C.F.R. Part 54, Subpart E, as amended.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
