- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 7 amended by adding Section 29.0845 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 29.0845. ONLINE TUTORIALS FOR END-OF-COURSE
- 9 ASSESSMENT INSTRUMENT PREPARATION. (a) The agency shall develop
- 10 or contract for the development of interactive electronic tutorials
- 11 that provide a comprehensive review for each end-of-course
- 12 <u>assessment instrument listed in Section 39.023(c).</u>
- (b) From funds appropriated for purposes of this section,
- 14 the agency shall make the tutorials developed under Subsection (a)
- 15 available to public school students through the state virtual
- 16 school network under Chapter 30A.
- 17 (b-1) The agency shall provide the tutorials developed
- 18 under Subsection (a) through the state virtual school network not
- 19 <u>later than the 2016-2017 school year. This subsection expires</u>
- 20 September <u>1, 2017.</u>
- 21 (c) A public school student may not be charged a fee for
- 22 access to a tutorial provided through the state virtual school
- 23 network under this section or materials used in conjunction with a
- 24 tutorial.

- 1 (d) The commissioner shall adopt rules as necessary to
- 2 <u>administer this section.</u>
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
