4	SECTION 1. Section 497.021, Government Code, is amended to
5	read as follows:
6	Sec. 497.021. AUTHORITY. This subchapter governs the sale
7	of prison-made products [to governmental agencies].
8	SECTION 2. Section 497.022, Government Code, is amended to
9	read as follows:
10	Sec. 497.022. CONTRACTS. The department may contract with:
11	(1) another state, the federal government, a foreign
12	government, or an agency of any of those governments to manufacture
13	for or sell to those governments prison-made articles or products;
14	(2) a private or independent institution of higher
15	education to manufacture for or sell to that school or institution
16	prison-made articles or products; [or]
17	(3) <u>a private vendor that contracts with the</u>
18	department under Chapter 495 to manufacture for or sell to that
19	private vendor prison-made articles or products;
20	(4) an employee or retired employee of a state agency,
21	as defined by Section 2052.101, to sell to that employee or retired
22	employee prison-made articles or products; or
23	(5) a private school or a visually handicapped person
24	in this state to manufacture Braille textbooks or other

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instructional aids for the education of visually handicapped 1 2 persons. SECTION 3. Section 497.025, Government Code, is amended by 3 adding Subsections (d) and (e) to read as follows: 4 5 (d) The board shall adopt rules and develop best practices governing the purchase of articles and products under this 6 7 subchapter by a private vendor that contracts with the department 8 under Chapter 495, provided that: 9 (1) the articles and products may be shipped or used only in this state and may not be resold; and 10 (2) the office may not sell articles and products to a 11 12 private vendor if the private vendor currently purchases the articles or products from a private business that has its primary 13 place of business in this state. 14 15 (e) The board shall adopt rules governing the purchase of articles and products under this subchapter by an employee or 16 17 retired employee of a state agency, as defined by Section 2052.101. The rules must provide that articles and products may be shipped and 18 19 used only in this state and may not be resold. In adopting the rules, the board shall determine: 20 21 (1) the articles and products available for purchase; 22 (2) the minimum quantity or price of an order; the delivery and production schedule; and 23 (3) 24 (4) any other factors relevant to ensuring that the office is not impeded in effectively meeting the purposes of this 25 26 subchapter. SECTION 4. Section 497.028, Government Code, is amended to 27

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1 read as follows:

Sec. 497.028. CATALOGS. The office shall prepare catalogs that accurately and completely describe articles and products produced under this subchapter. The office shall send copies of the catalogs to all state agencies and make the catalogs available to political subdivisions, private vendors that contract with the department under Chapter 495, and employees and retired employees of state agencies, as defined by Section 2052.101.

9 SECTION 5. Not later than August 31, 2016, the Texas 10 Department of Criminal Justice shall adopt rules as required by 11 Sections 497.025(d) and (e), Government Code, as added by this Act. 12 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
