H.B. No. 1816

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the training requirements for renewal of a private
3 pesticide applicator license.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 76.113, Agriculture Code, is amended by
6 adding Subsection (e) to read as follows:

7 (e) A private applicator may satisfy all or part of the
8 training requirement under Subsection (d) by completing an equal
9 amount of training in water conservation.

10 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
11 to training received on or after the effective date of this Act.
12 Training received before the effective date of this Act is governed
13 by the law in effect when the training was received, and the former
14 law is continued in effect for that purpose.

15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
19 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
