- 2 relating to the date for the election of directors of the Hill
- 3 Country Underground Water Conservation District.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 8844.104, Special District Local Laws
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 8844.104. ELECTION DATE. Each <u>odd-numbered</u>
- 8 [even-numbered] year, the board shall hold an election in the
- 9 district on the uniform election date in $\underline{\text{May}}$ [November] to elect the
- 10 appropriate number of directors. Section 41.001(a)(2), Election
- 11 Code, does not apply to the district.
- 12 SECTION 2. The board of directors of the Hill Country
- 13 Underground Water Conservation District shall adjust the terms of
- 14 office to conform to a change in the election date made by this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 16 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 17 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 18 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 19 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 20 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 21 Government Code.
- 22 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 23 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 24 Environmental Quality.

- 1 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 2 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 3 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 4 representatives within the required time.
- 5 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 6 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 7 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 8 and accomplished.
- 9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
