- 9 CHAPTER 47. GENERAL PROVISIONS
- Sec. 47.001. APPLICABILITY OF DEFINITIONS. (a) Except as
- 11 provided by Subsection (b), the definitions in Chapter 101 apply to
- 12 terms used in this title.
- 13 (b) If a term defined in this title has a meaning different
- 14 from the meaning provided by Chapter 101, the meaning provided by
- 15 this title prevails.
- Sec. 47.002. APPLICABILITY OF LAWS RELATING TO ATTORNEYS AD
- 17 LITEM AND AMICUS ATTORNEYS. Chapter 107 applies to the appointment
- 18 of an attorney ad litem or amicus attorney under this title.
- 19 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 20 a proceeding that is commenced on or after the effective date of
- 21 this Act. A proceeding that is commenced before that date is
- 22 governed by the law as it existed on the date the proceeding was
- 23 commenced, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 24 purpose.
