- 5 SECTION 1. Section 22.01(c), Penal Code, is amended to read

- 7 (c) An offense under Subsection (a)(2) or (3) is a Class C
- 8 misdemeanor, except that the offense is $[\div$
- 9 $\left[\frac{(1)}{(1)}\right]$ a Class A misdemeanor if the offense is
- 10 committed:
- 11 (1) under Subsection (a)(3) against an elderly
- 12 individual or disabled individual, as those terms are defined by
- 13 Section 22.04; or
- 14 (2) [a Class B misdemeanor if the offense is
- 15 committed] by any [a] person, other than [who is not] a sports
- 16 participant who is an athlete younger than 19 years of age, against
- 17 <u>another</u> [a] person the actor knows is a sports participant either:
- 18 (A) while the participant is performing duties or
- 19 responsibilities in the participant's capacity as a sports
- 20 participant; or
- 21 (B) in retaliation for or on account of the
- 22 participant's performance of a duty or responsibility within the

- 24 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only

- 1 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 2 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 3 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
- 4 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
- 5 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
- 6 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
- 7 before that date.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
