Section 22.01(e), Penal Code, is amended by

1 adding Subdivision (2) to read as follows:

2 (2) "Child," "disabled individual," and "elderly
3 individual" have the meanings assigned by Section 22.04.

4 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 5 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 6 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed, 7 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For 8 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the 9 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred 10 before that date. 11
