## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter K, Chapter 431, Health and Safety
7	Code, is amended by adding Section 431.250 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 431.250. NOTIFICATION OF IMPLEMENTATION OF
9	ENFORCEMENT OF FEDERAL ACT. Before the department or the
10	Department of Agriculture may enter into an agreement, memorandum
11	of understanding, or contract with a federal agency to implement or
12	enforce a provision of the federal Act, the affected department
13	shall:
14	(1) publish the proposed agreement, memorandum, or
15	contract in the Texas Register;
16	(2) allow at least 90 days for the public to submit
17	comments after publication;
18	(3) consult with and provide a copy of the submitted
19	public comments to the presiding officers of the standing
20	committees of the senate and house of representatives having
21	primary jurisdiction over food safety regulations; and
22	(4) publish a final notice in the Texas Register that
23	includes:
24	(A) a summary of the public comments and

- 1 consultation with the presiding officers;
- 2 (B) a determination on whether the affected
- 3 department will enter into the proposed agreement, memorandum, or
- 4 contract; and
- 5 (C) any changes made as a result of the public
- 6 comments or consultation with the presiding officers.
- 7 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 8 to an agreement, memorandum of understanding, or contract entered
- 9 into on or after the effective date of this Act. An agreement,
- 10 memorandum, or contract entered into before the effective date of
- 11 this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the agreement,
- 12 memorandum, or contract was entered into, and that law is continued
- 13 in effect for that purpose.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
