## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to certain assessments for children in the conservatorship
- 3 of the Department of Family and Protective Services.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 266, Family Code, is amended by adding
- 6 Section 266.012 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 266.012. COMPREHENSIVE ASSESSMENTS. (a) Not later
- 8 than the 45th day after the date a child enters the conservatorship
- 9 of the department, the child shall receive a developmentally
- 10 appropriate comprehensive assessment. The assessment must include:
- 11 (1) a screening for trauma; and
- 12 (2) interviews with individuals who have knowledge of
- 13 the child's needs.
- 14 (b) The department shall develop guidelines regarding the
- 15 contents of an assessment report.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
