9	REPORT. (a) As a component of the official monthly report submitted
10	to the Office of Court Administration of the Texas Judicial System
11	under Section 71.035, a district court or county court at law shall
12	report:
13	(1) the number of persons summoned to serve as grand
14	jurors under Chapter 19, Code of Criminal Procedure, for each term
15	<u>of court;</u>
16	(2) the age, gender, and race of each person described
17	by Subdivision (1);
18	(3) the number of grand juries impaneled under Chapter
19	19, Code of Criminal Procedure;
20	(4) the age, gender, and racial composition of each
21	grand jury described by Subdivision (3);
22	(5) the number of persons summoned to serve as petit
23	jurors under Chapter 35, Code of Criminal Procedure, for each
24	applicable case before the court;

1	(6) the age, gender, and race of each person described
2	by Subdivision (5);
3	(7) the number of petit juries impaneled under Chapter
4	35, Code of Criminal Procedure; and
5	(8) the age, gender, and racial composition of each
6	petit jury described by Subdivision (7).
7	(b) Not later than January 31 of each year, each county
8	shall submit to the office of court administration a report:
9	(1) comparing for the preceding calendar year the age,
10	gender, and racial composition of the county's grand and petit
11	juries with the age, gender, and racial demographics of the county;
12	and
13	(2) explaining any discrepancies between the two sets
14	of demographic information described by Subdivision (1).
15	(c) The office of court administration shall make each
16	report provided under Subsection (b) available to the public and
17	members of the press.
18	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
