## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to notice of hospital and emergency medical services
- 3 liens.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 55.005(d), Property Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (e), not later than the
- 8 fifth business day after the date a hospital or emergency medical
- 9 services provider files the notice of lien under Subsection (a)
- 10 [receives notice from the county clerk that a notice of lien filed
- 11 under Subsection (a)(2) has been recorded in the county records],
- 12 the hospital or emergency medical services provider must send a
- 13 written notice to the injured individual or the injured
- 14 individual's legal representative, by regular mail, to the
- 15 individual's last known address, informing the individual that:
- 16 (1) the lien will attach to any cause of action or
- 17 claim the individual may have against another person for the
- 18 individual's injuries; and
- 19 (2) the lien does not attach to real property owned by
- 20 the individual.
- 21 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 22 to a lien for services provided to an injured individual on or after
- 23 the effective date of this Act. A lien for services provided before
- 24 the effective date of this Act is governed by the law as it existed

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- 1 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 2 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2015.
